Levels and Components Offered

STARTED LEVEL: Containers & Interior

ADVANCED LEVEL: Containers & Interior

This titling event is being held under the rules of the Sporting Detection Dogs Association. Dogs must be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age. Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the Rules and Regulations. See Master Rule Book on the SDDA web site www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca to familiarize yourself with all rules.

There are two competition streams in Started, Advanced and Excellent Levels: Working (W) and Amateur (A). Handlers or dogs working or previously employed in a professional capacity in detection as well as scent detection instructors/coaches/trainers/judges must enter the Working stream and will be ranked and placed (if placements are offered) separately from Amateurs. Be sure to indicate on the entry forms.

Important venue notes:

Dogs **MUST** be on leash when not crated, in your vehicle, or in the search areas.

Dog waste must be picked up. The flooring is laminate. Please do not allow dogs to potty on or near the building. There are potty areas behind and to the side of building

ENTRY INFORMATION Fees: \$32 per Started/Advanced Component entered.

Cancellation of entries after closing will incur a \$10.00 handling fee.

Your entry is not confirmed until payment is received. ETRANSFERS to hilltoptrials@gmail.com

PAW coverings are required on all interior searches. Competitors are responsible for any damage cause by their dogs during a search

Times will be provided once full or closed and numbers per level have been counted.
Bitches in season will be accepted and will run last in each component. Please advise us in advance of your arrival if you will be attending with a bitch in season so that run orders can be adjusted.
Refunds (minus a \$5 processing fee) will be given for any dog or handler withdrawing for medical reasons before the closing date.
Refunds after the closing date are contingent on being filled by a team on the wait list.

GENERAL INFORMATION COVID PRECAUTIONS: Competitors **MUST** be double vaccinated and have proof on their persons . Masks required for all interior components and walk-throughs. Please remember to physically distance. If you are feeling unwell or have been out of the province or in contact with someone exhibiting symptoms, please do not attend. Registration in this trial means you have agree to the waivers on the entry forms.

Awards: qualifying ribbons will be presented per component and rosettes for titles and placements.
Food: the venue is near several restaurants, including a Tim Hortons in St Isadore near the 417 overpass
Crating: there is no indoor crating at this facility.

Please be prepared to contain your dogs in your vehicles. parking lot east of the venue.
